### Legislative

### Enhancements

- Transactions will no longer be selected for RFI/Non-RFI by default.
- The Ordinary Hours will now reflect on the standard payslip layout.
- The value for the income on the UI-19 report has been changed to reflect the UIF Income (Calculation Total 17).

## **Defects**

- Only the taxable portion of travel will now be included in tax code 4587.
- The default 7% has been removed from transaction 7003 and will no longer appear when creating a new company.
- When creating a manual copy company excluding employees, you will no longer receive Error 380.
- You will no longer receive Error 380 when printing the Payment Method report.

## **Councils**

- Road Freight – You will no longer receive an exception for the R6xxbenefit transactions.
- MIBCO – The MIBCO calendar for 2021 has been updated.
- Security – The leading zeros for ID numbers will now be included on the excel-format PSSPF Monthly Return.
